

## Annual Meeting FAQs

**Why the voting change?** Since we now have two congregations and four services, we wanted to make it simple to vote by making it convenient.

**Why the evening meeting?** Since we now have two congregations, we wanted to offer an easy time for everyone from both to be able to come.

**How do I know which congregation a Parish Council member attends?** That information is contained in the biography of the nominee. However, when you vote for a nominee, you are not electing a “representative” to a congregation. All members work on issues of vision and strategy for our church as a whole.

**Why isn't my name on the Mission Roster (or Overland Park Roster)?** Your name appears on the roster according to our congregation of record. We apologize for any inconvenience. Please contact Trish Nelson at 913-991-2001 and we will correct any inaccuracies.

**When will we find out who won the Parish Council elections?** The nominees will be contacted the afternoon of January 28, prior to the business portion of the annual meeting with the voting results. The new Parish Council members will be introduced at the Monday evening portion of the annual meeting.

**I voted already, but I just met a candidate and I really liked him/her and I want to change my vote. Can I do that before the annual meeting?** No.

**Will we be “meeting” during the voting time on Sunday morning, January 27?** No, we will not be meeting. Worship services will be held at both congregations at their regular times during Sunday voting.

**What will we do at the business meeting on Monday night?** Like all Annual Meetings, we will receive our Finance Report and 2019 Budget, and take care of some general business.

While all of this might seem a little confusing, our desire is to offer every member a chance to vote for Parish Council and attend the business portion of the Annual Meeting. Any feedback, good or bad, is welcomed and appreciated.
